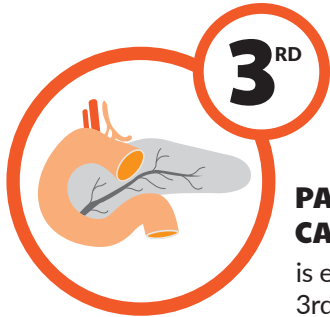


CANCER IN CANADA IN 2021

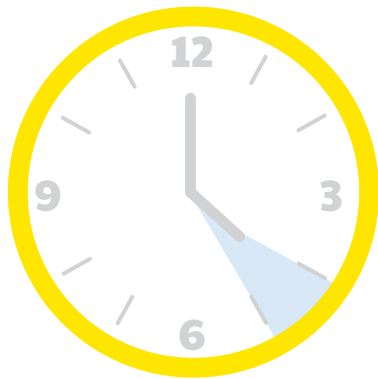

is expected to be the 3rd leading cause of cancer death

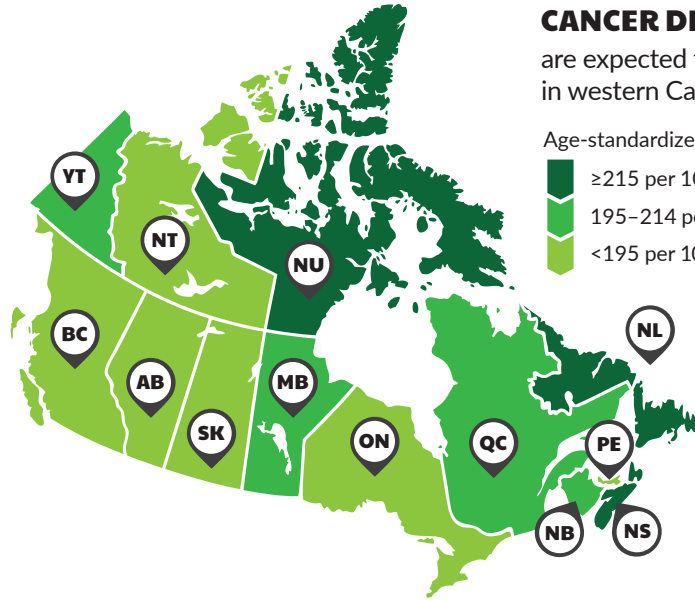


EVERY HOUR IN 2021,

<195 per 100K

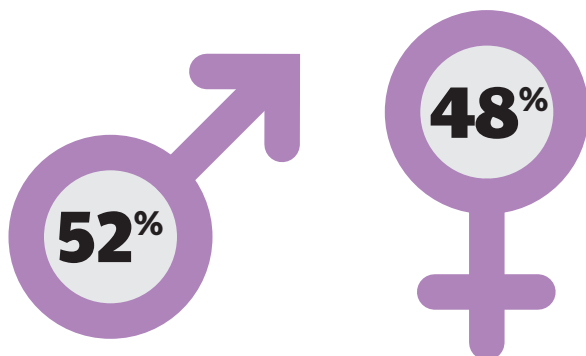


PROSTATE CANCER

FIVE-YEAR NET CANCER SURVIVAL

is 64%, up from 55% in the early 1990s
