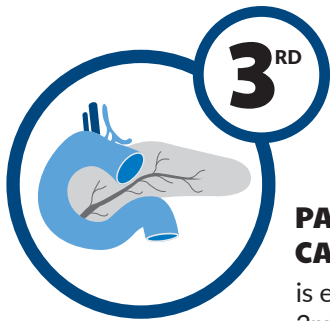


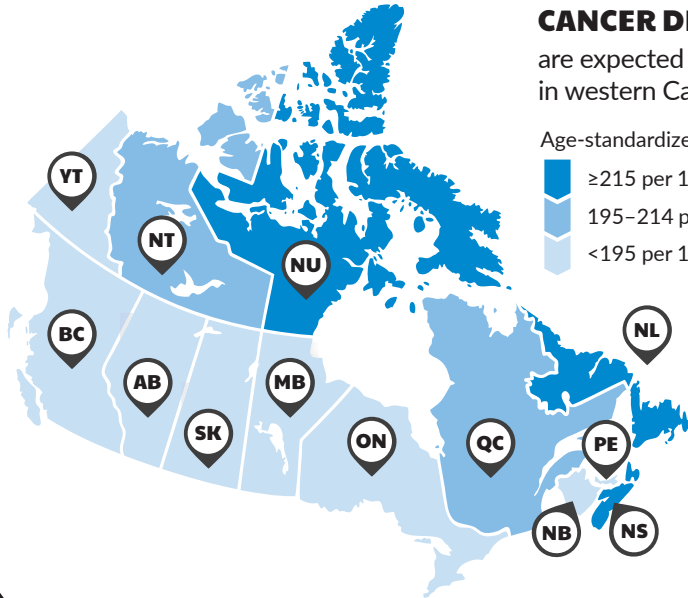
CANCER IN CANADA IN 2022

Projected estimates of cancer in Canada in 2022 is a study published in the Canadian Medical Association Journal (CMAJ). It provides new estimates of the number and rate of new cancer cases and deaths for 22 cancer types by province, territory and sex. Below are some of the key findings from the study.



PANCREATIC CANCER

is expected to be the 3rd leading cause of cancer death in 2022

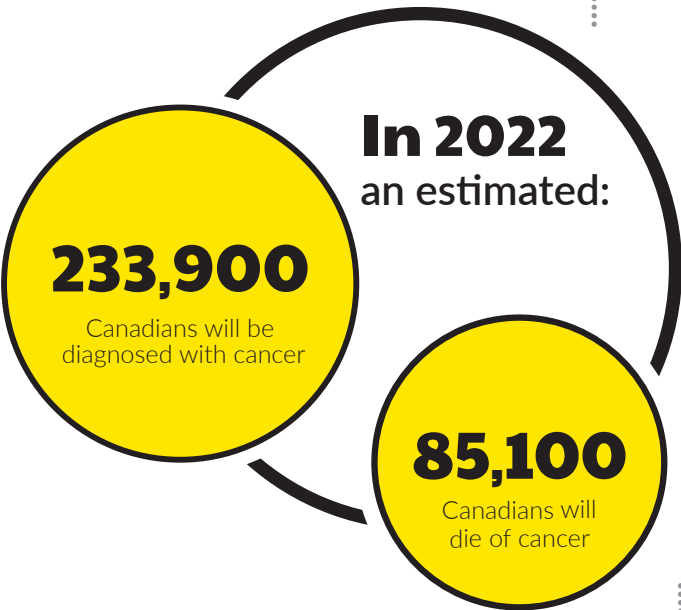


CANCER DEATH RATES

are expected to be lowest in western Canada

Age-standardized mortality rate

- ≥215 per 100K
- 195-214 per 100K
- <195 per 100K



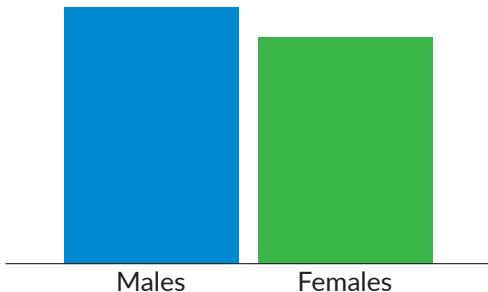
LUNG CANCER

incidence rate among males has declined significantly since 1984



NUMBER OF CANCER DEATHS AMONG MALES

is 13% higher than in females



LUNG CANCER

is expected to cause more deaths than breast, colorectal and pancreatic cancers combined
