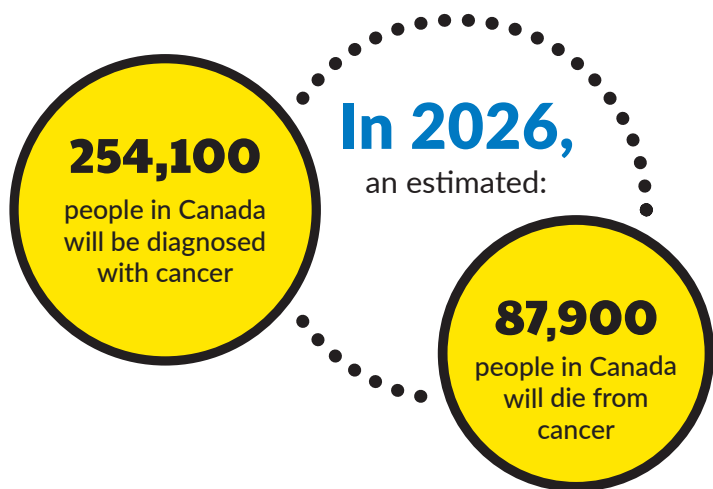


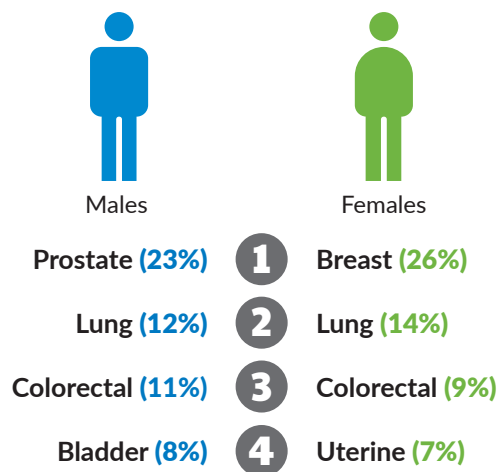
CANCER IN CANADA IN 2026

Projected estimates of cancer in Canada in 2026 is a study published in the Canadian Medical Association Journal (CMAJ). It provides updated estimates of the number and rate of new cancer cases and deaths for 23 cancer types by province, territory and sex. Below are some of the key findings from the study.

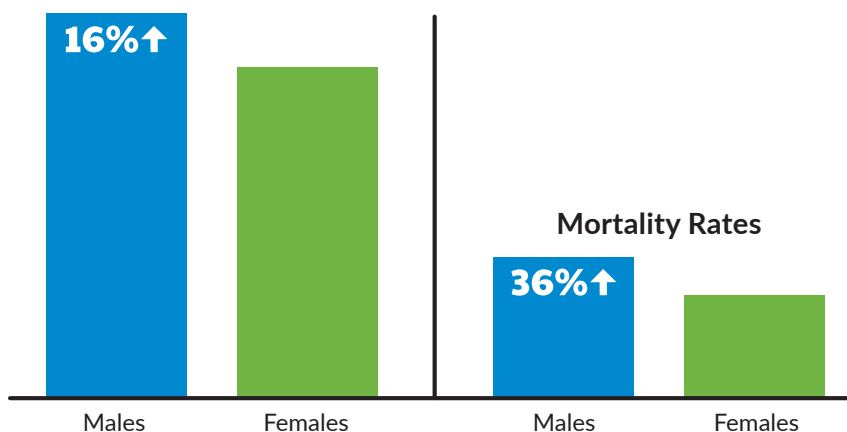
IMPACT OF CANCER IN CANADA



MOST COMMONLY DIAGNOSED CANCERS IN 2026



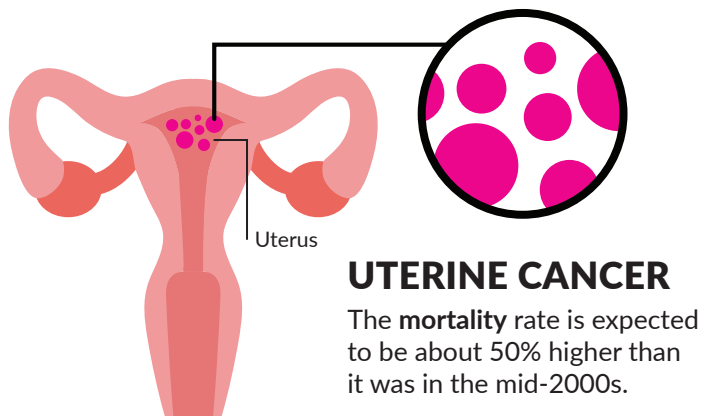
Incidence Rates



HIGHER RATES IN MALES

In 2026, males are expected to have a 16% higher incidence and a 36% higher mortality rate than females.*

*Cancer data are currently analyzed based on assigned sex at birth or male/female binary.



BLADDER CANCER

Compared to a decade ago, mortality rates are expected to be 24% lower for males and 17% lower for females.
