
Preventing cervical cancer in Canada



Cervical cancer is the most preventable cancer in Canada.



About **1,300** cervical cancer cases could have been prevented in 2015.







Together, we can reduce the number of cervical cancer cases in the future by increasing HPV vaccinations, decreasing tobacco smoking and decreasing exposure to second-hand smoke

*All cervical cancers are caused by HPV, but not all HPV infections will lead to cervical cancer.

Other risk factors, like tobacco, increase the likelihood that an HPV infection will lead to cervical cancer.
